

CPNS COVID-19 Cleaning & Disinfecting Protocol

as of 7/14/20

Safety is our highest priority at CPNS and, this year, that includes a more rigorous cleaning protocol.

First, our classes will be held primarily in “the outdoor classroom”, as there is strong evidence that the risk of coronavirus transmission is lower outside. Because our yard is a shared space after preschool hours, before your child enters the yard, frequently touched surfaces will have been cleaned with a two-step process: a wipe down with the non-toxic H2Orange2 [concentrate](#) followed by a hydrogen peroxide spray that is on [List N: disinfectants for use against Covid-19](#). It will dwell to combat germs and then be left to evaporate. Teachers and parents will assist in this practice.

The bathroom will be sanitized after each use.

Frequent hand washing will be encouraged as well as required at the beginning of the session, after using the bathroom, before eating, after eating and at pick up time.

The dishwasher and on-site washing machine will both be frequently utilized for cleaning purposes.

We will be laundering any CPNS items that a child has used.

Additionally, to reduce cross over, we will make every effort for each class to have a distinct set of play materials that will be rotated every few weeks. In the event that a class utilizes the same set of play materials, they will be disinfected in between class usage (i.e. tricycles)

Similarly, each class will have one or two inside rooms that will be used exclusively by that class for three weeks, so as to minimize exposure.

Puppets and cloth stuffed animals will be removed entirely.

Sensory bins will be single use only.

The reopening committee is keeping up to date with county, state and CDC guidelines and will be continuing to fine tune our cleaning and sanitizing protocols.
